Master's in teacher leadership - date change!

You are invited to attend an open house to learn more about Seattle Pacific University's (SPU) Master of Education in Teacher Leadership program. This event will take place on <u>May 23</u>, at 4:30 PM in the Morton Johnson room at the Resource Center.

The MEd in Teacher Leadership Program at SPU offers teachers current educational theory, research and professional practices to enhance not only their knowledge and skills as they serve their students, but also provides a foundation of leadership skills to enhance teacher capabilities in a number of school-based roles, from department chair, to instructional coach. The unique aspect of this program is that it is cohort-based, offering a combination of online classes as well as face-to-face courses offered in your own district, with instructors who are both from the university, but also your own district teachers and leaders. The cohortbased program also offers a tuition discount. In addition, you would have the opportunity to use some of the elective credits as ProTeach or National Board credits.

We're going to say it again!

Your unused annual (personal) leave will be **automatically cashed out** at the sub rate of pay (\$159). If you want to carry over days to next year, you must notify the district prior to June 30, indicating that you want to carry over your unused days on a 1-for-1 basis.

- Send your request to <u>Leave@lwsd.org</u> keep a copy of your e-mail and the auto-reply response from the District for your records.
- Important please note:
- If you already have days that you've carried over from prior years, you MUST indicate that you want to continue to carry them over. If you do not notify the district, your carryover days will be cashed out.
- If you are interested in a combination (some cashed out and some carried over), you also MUST notify the district.
- Please <u>don't contact the District to find out how much unused annual leave you</u> <u>have remaining</u> – you can easily check your balance on Employee Access.
- You'll receive your annual leave cash out in your August paycheck.

Can you find it in the contract?

The LWSD/LWEA contract can sometimes be a confusing place when you are looking for information. If you are looking for specific information on a certain subject, there are a couple of places you can look:

- Index the last page of the contract has a very comprehensive index of items that you may need and the specific page number(s) of where to find them.
- Search if you are looking at the contract on the LWEA website or the LWSD Portal, you can search for a phrase or set of words. From the edit toolbar – pull down to "Find" and fill in the specific item you need to find.
