AN EVENING FOR BUILDING COMMUNITY & CONNECTIONS WITH LWEA MEMBERS OF COLOR

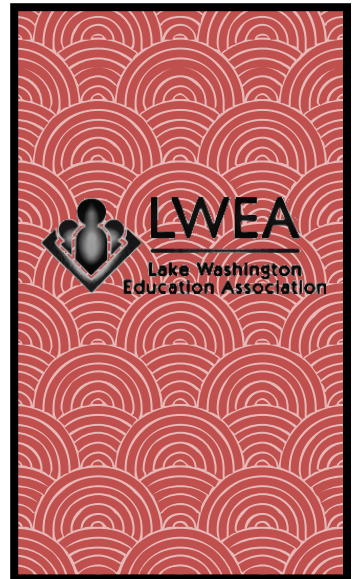
At our last “*Wine and Wisdom*,” we had a great conversation around implicit bias. We learned what it is and how to recognize it when it occurs.
