This school year marks several significant changes in the Lake Washington School District:

- Two, much needed, new schools - Clara Barton and Ella Baker - open their doors to students and staff
- We welcomed nearly 300 new educators to the district at this year's week-long EIA event
- Dr. Jane Stavem was introduced as our new Superintendent continuing with and building on the work of outgoing Superintendent Dr. Traci Pierce
- Your union, the LWEA, and the Lake Washington School District agreed to a new Salary Schedule resulting in substantial raises for our educators, recognition of prior outside service experience for our PT, OT, SLP, and Psychologist colleagues, the adoption of a flat \$50/hour "timecard rate", and the implementation of a new Professional Fund process.
- And, of course, a new LWEA President occupies the very big shoes of our former President, Kevin Teeley, I am honored to be that person.

I hope summer afforded you time for fun and relaxation. I look forward to supporting you as you take on the important work of teaching the students of Lake Washington Schools.
